Teacher Job Description

Independent Contractor shall provide the following services to students:

- Communication is vital. Teachers will work with students and families, communicating weekly. ALL communication needs to be catalogued in ASSIST
- Start off on the right foot. Send a welcome email, introductory video, and make an initial phone call to the home all within the first week of enrollment. Additional phone calls should occur monthly. Be explicit in your expectations. (see samples of a teacher video and intro letter here)
- Timeliness is essential. Respond to all communication within one school day, return submitted work with two school days, and return all final exams and post final grades within five school days.
- Accessibility is key. Teachers need to hold two one-hour office hour sessions each week. These office hours need to be posted in the teacher bio, signature line, and shared in the introductory letter.
- We are a team. Advantages hosts a monthly teachers' lounge where we all come together virtually to share best practices, challenges, and philosophies. This sessions are recorded and posted, but your presence is strongly encouraged.
- Support for success. ASI encourages teacher growth with ADVANTAGES One on One. ADVANTAGES One on One is a collaboration with an ASI success manager and each individual teacher. These staff development meetings happen three times per year.

Teacher Job Description (con't)

- Teacher Qualifications Our teachers all have a Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of 10 years teaching experience or a Master's Degree; are certified in the relevant subject area, and have online teaching experience
- Technical Competencies and Skills Our teachers must possess strong oral and written English communication skills; ability to work independently and as a part of a team, are self-motivated, and utilize all required and recommended ADVANTAGES computer applications
- Working Conditions. Physical ability- tasks may involve extended periods of time at a keyboard; ADLS is an Equal Opportunity Employer. ADA requires ADLS to provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities. Prospective and current employees are invited to discuss accommodations.
- Invoicing for payment Teachers invoice for payment after the student(s) have completed the course and the final grade is posted. Teachers must send an email thanking/congratulating the student and informing them on the final grade and complete the end of course survey. - Independent Contractor responsibilities Our teachers are independent contractors. Contractors are required to provide their own computer, internet connectivity, and consumable supplies.

Communication and Support

- Offline Communication Teachers will document all offline communication in student file under Communications.
- **Student Inactivity** Teachers will communicate with students and parents in ASSIST after 9 days of inactivity. If no update is given by student or parent, teacher will notify Success Manager by email on the 14th day of inactivity.
- **Issuing final grades** Teacher will email Success Manager upon posting final grade for a course.
- Discipline concerns Teachers will document infraction in student profile under Comments and Documents. Teachers will
 email Success Manager and Head of School upon each discipline violation in accordance with ASI student conduct policies.
- Leave time Teachers will notify Success Manager and Head of School when not available for weekly office hours, time off, or
 extended leave. If leave requires a substitute teacher one week notification minimum is essential for proper classroom
 management.
- Enrollment Cap Teachers will notify Success Manager when approaching desired enrollment cap.
- Concerns Teachers are encouraged to consult with Success Managers regarding any platform or student concerns as needed.



Policies


- Honor Code Academic dishonesty in online classes will not be tolerated. Students may, of course, work faster than originally projected on the pace charts. If students fail to adhere to ASI's progress policy, found here the student may be dropped from the course. Reenrollment incurs a \$50 fee.
- Plagiarism At ASI, teachers have a TurnItIn.com account. Turnitin is plagiarism detection software that scans student work for matched text by comparing the work to a large database of student work, publications, and materials on the internet.
- NCAA and AP Courses When teaching AP courses or courses for our NCAA candidates, no assignments or tests can be omitted. (AP courses can omit discussions only)
